

Our world-renowned researchers are at the forefront of cutting-edge developments such as understanding the long-term effects of Covid-19.





Your gift can help transform our hospitals' spaces, while also providing the very best environment to train the next generation of healthcare experts.

#### Types of gifts

There are several ways you can include a gift in your Will, large or small. Your solicitor will advise you on how to include a gift, and we can provide suggested wording to ensure your gift is made exactly the way you intend.





#### The next step is to decide the type of gift you would like to leave. You can choose between:

A residuary gift is a percentage (%) of your estate once all other specific gifts in your Will have been distributed (the 'residue'). You can leave the whole of your residue to us, or a percentage of it. Many people choose to give a residual gift because it maintains its value with inflation.

A pecuniary gift is a monetary gift from your estate, usually a set sum of money.

A specific gift is a particular item, or group of items, of property. For example, you may leave personal possessions, land, property or shares to a named beneficiary.

Once you've considered all your loved ones, you may want to leave a gift to a cause you're passionate about - making Southmead Hospital even better. By leaving a percentage of your estate to your local NHS, you will help to transform your hospital services and make a huge difference to the lives of people across the South West.

Most people choose to leave a residual gift for peace of mind. This means your gift maintains its purchasing power. By leaving 10 per cent or more of your estate to charities within your Will planning, you can reduce your Inheritance Tax liability.
